## LOCATION

The Senior Civil Engineer will ideally be based ideally in Whitehorse; however Vancouver will be considered for the right candidate. Regular site visits will be required for coordinating directly with our Whitehorse office and may also be required for site-based management work.

## KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure all engineering work packages for government authorities align with Western Copper and Gold (WRN) decision making.
- Maintain the executive and senior leadership informed of key issues/risks for the Casino project development to allow timely and effective decisions.
- Work in collaboration with permitting and approvals team, to ensure work is defensible for government regulators (i.e. YESAB), Quarry Mine Licensing and Canadian Dam Safety.
- Ensure Tailings Dam designs are performed in alignment with Global Industry Standard on Tailings Management (GISTM).
- Work collaboratively with mine engineering, process engineering and geology teams, on constructability reviews for all project infrastructure, including Heap Leach Facility, Tailings Management Facility, waste dumps, stockpiles and ancillary infrastructure ON and OFF site.
- Work collaboratively with the broader engineering team on offsite infrastructure; port facilities, resource and municipal road designs
- Work collaboratively and in alignment with Environment and Permitting on site water balance inputs, modelling and optimization.
- Approve invoices, track costs and ensure work is budgeted and approved and aligns with WRN financial reporting requirements.
- Other duties as assigned.
